DRESS CODE

1. **STUDENTS MUST WEAR CLOTHING THAT IS SEMI-FORMAL AND APPROPRIATE.**
2. If a student's attire does not comply with the said dress code, he or she will be denied admittance to the dance. Parents will be notified and the student will be sent home.
3. Inappropriate attire includes, but is not limited to, jeans, t-shirts, sweatshirts, and sweatpants. All other school dress code should be followed.

TICKET SALES

1. Tickets **MUST** be purchased in advance online at www.locallevellevents.com
2. Absolutely **NO** tickets will be sold at the door for the dance. Ticket sales are online only.
3. Students who arrive at the dance without a pre-purchased ticket will be denied entry.
4. Only the original purchaser of the ticket can use the ticket. Tickets cannot be resold or given to other students.
5. **Ticket sales begin on Monday, September 16. Tickets will cost \$12/individual or \$24/couple.**
Ticket sales will end on Saturday, September 28, 7pm. All guest tickets must be purchased by Friday, September 28.

ATTENDEES

1. Only students who are **currently in high school or graduates from the 2018-2019 school year** are allowed into the dance.
2. Students who will be attending as guests from other schools will be required to complete an information form that includes parental/emergency contact information, parent signature, as well as the signature of one of the guest's school administrators.
3. Completed information forms must be turned in when tickets are purchased.

ALCOHOL/DRUG POLICY

1. No student under the influence of alcohol or any other illegal substance will be granted admission to the dance.
2. Any student who chooses to violate this code may face disciplinary action from the administration and law enforcement.

LATE ARRIVAL/EARLY DEPARTURE POLICY

1. Students must arrive within one hour of the scheduled starting time (no later than 9:00pm).
2. Students will not be allowed to leave the dance until one hour before the scheduled end of the dance unless there is an emergency (no earlier than 10:00 pm).
3. Students arriving or wishing to leave outside of the times above may have their parents contacted.

APPROPRIATE DANCING

1. This is a school dance and your behavior should be appropriate.
2. Dancing that is overly suggestive – i.e. excessive touching, fondling, and/or excessive displays of affection – will not be permitted.
3. No violent or "mosh pit" style dancing is permitted.

All students are expected to follow the regulations listed in the New Albany High School Student Code of Conduct. Purchase of ticket serves as your acknowledgement of all listed rules above and your agreement to follow those rules.
