Graphic Arts Boot Camp	Students will learn the basic design principles; apply their creative ability to create a set of custom memo pads using Apple IMac computers and Adobe InDesign and Photoshop.
Medical Detectives Boot Camp	What is a medical detective? As medical detectives, students will investigate three main topics; human vital signs, human senses, and a forensic science exploration.
Design and Modeling Boot Camp	Students will learn creative design concepts using state of the art computers and software. Following industry standards, participants will create and produce their own ink pen using Autodesk Inventor CAD software and 3D printing technology.
Green Architecture Boot Camp	Creating your own design can be a very exciting task. You will design a dream room, complete with furnishings using Autodesk Revit Architectural Software.
Broadcast Boot Camp	Students will have “hands on” experience filling all the roles found in an actual news broadcast. This camp will produce a short broadcast.
Babysitting Boot Camp	Students will learn basic babysitting skills and childcare techniques including diaper changing, bottle-feeding, an various other infant care skills using an infant simulator doll. The course will prepare the students for babysitting and they will have the opportunity to explore different careers working with young children.
Automotive Boot Camp	Students will learn and have basic skills used on today’s vehicles to perform vehicle preventative maintenance. Students will learn to check all vehicle fluids, monitor vehicle tires for wear, conditions, and pressure levels. All students will better understand safety and preventative maintenance.
Marketing Boot Camp	Students will participate in a simulated “shark tank” fun activity. Each student-camp team will prepare a proposal of their created product for presentation to a panel of judges.
CPR Boot Camp	Students will get trained in CPR, AED, and first Aid.
Health Occupation Boot Camp	Students will be introduced to skills related to health professions and a variety of medical fields.
Culinary Boot Camp	Students will learn how to prepare quick meals using safe kitchen practices and proper techniques.
Intro to Computer Programming	Students will learn basic programming and design their own game online.
